

Bursaries Offered

For the 5th year, The Leavenworth International Accordion Celebration committee is pleased to announce that bursaries will be available for young competitors. The term, “bursary”, is more widely used in Canada; for those in the United States the “bursary” is likened to a scholarship. To receive a bursary amounting to \$150 (US) a young person must:

1. Be age 18 or under on June 18
2. Participate in at least one individual competition category or evaluation
3. Submit a **handwritten letter via postal service, electronic scan/email** stating their goals, interest, and plans for studying and playing the accordion plus the intended use of the money
4. Bursaries will be awarded during the awards ceremony at LIAC; no bursaries will be given to an individual without the submission of a hand written letter posted as directed below
5. **Bursary letters may be sent with the competition form**
